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# Welcome in Chemnitz

STADT DER MODERNE



*Hardly any other city in Germany has changed its face as much in the last few decades as Chemnitz. Bombed in the second world war and deformed in the GDR times by utopian urban planning based on the socialist model, the inner city in particular had to be reinvented after reunification.*

One thought back to the early days, when Chemnitz as “Saxon Manchester” came to full bloom economically, culturally and architecturally. Many buildings have been restored, especially on the Kassberg, the largest art nouveau district in Europe. And what couldn’t be saved was rebuilt under the influence of current trends.

Today Chemnitz is a modern city with almost 250,00 inhabitants. Locates at the foot of the “Erzgebirge” and not far from the EU member states Czech Republic and Poland, it is shaped by a region with more than a million inhabitants:

As a business location with a technical university and many research institutions; as a city with attractive jobs, lots of greenery, a high quality of life and last but not least as a cultural center with a colorful range of leisure activities.

It wasn’t for nothing that in 2006 Chemnitz received the DIFA-AWARD for inner-city quarters, which honors the successful mix of retail, office, gastronomy, living, leisure and culture in the newly created inner city.



**2006** Ten years after the city council decision, the DIFA-AWARD goes to Chemnitz for the successful development of the city center with the lively centre.

**1990** In a referendum, the majority of the citizens decided to rename the city. Chemnitz is getting its old name back.

**1974** The foundation stone for the “Fritz-Heckert” residential area is laid. Up to 90,000 residents found space in the second largest flat housing estate in the former GDR.

**1939-1945** Chemnitz is considered a strategically important location for arms production. As a result, the city experienced heavy bombing from the air, particularly in February 1945 and March 5. The city center and adjacent residential areas are almost completely destroyed.

**1918** The consequences of the First World War are particularly noticeable in Chemnitz. The long industrial boom comes to an abrupt end and many companies collapse. The result is a high unemployment.

**1862** The products of Chemnitz mechanical engineering enjoy an excellent international reputation and the city is also becoming a national center of the textile industry.

**Around 1800** The industrial revolution began in Chemnitz with the establishment of the first mechanical cotton spinning mill. In short time the “first factory and second trading town” was created in Saxony.

**1357** Chemnitz received the bleaching privilege and developed into a center of textile production and textile trade in the 14th and 15th centuries.

**2009** The “Start Up” innovation centre opens on the Smart System Campus in close proximity to TU Chemnitz and the Fraunhofer Institute. The goal is a settlement of young technology companies.

**1996** The city council decides to completely redevelop the inner city, one of the largest inner-city wastelands in Europe. Two years later the construction of the first part of the new city centre will start.

**1989** Tens of thousands of people demonstrates non-violently in the year of the fall of the wall to open up the GDR. Meanwhile, Karl-Marx-Stadt has over 300,000 inhabitants and is a centre for machine and vehicle construction, textile industry and electrical engineering in the highly existing GDR.

**1953** Chemnitz is renamed “Karl-Marx-Stadt”. The bombed old city centre will not be rebuilt. Instead, a completely new city center is being built with wide, open spaces based on the socialist model.

**1936** The company “Auto-Union” is moving its headquarters to the city, which just a few years ago had its highest population with 360,000 inhabitants.

**1883** Chemnitz is developing by leaps and bounds. With 103,000 inhabitants and many new districts, Chemnitz - known as “Saxon Manchester” – is becoming a big city.

**1848** The first steam locomotive is built in the “Saxon tool factory” found by Richard Hartmann. With the opening of his factories, Johann Zimmermann also establishes machine tool construction in Germany.

**1531** The famous doctor, mineralogist and mining scientist Dr. Georgius Agricola settles in the city and then acts as mayor for many years from 1546.

**1143** As a result of the granting of market rights, the Benedictine monastery on the Chemnitz river is first mentioned in a document

# Highlights

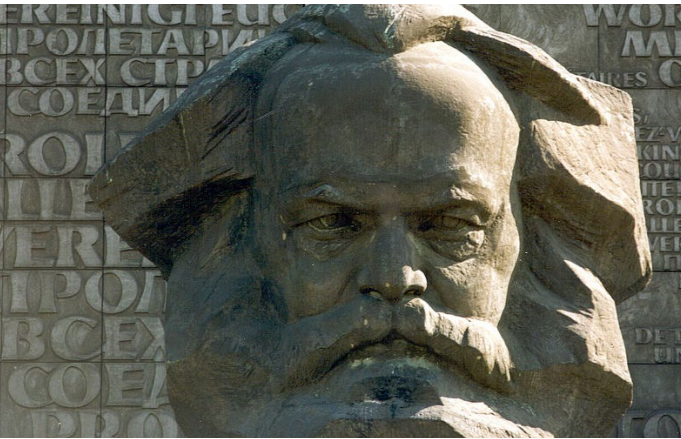
*Theatre square with opera (“Theaterplatz”) and art collections (“Kunstsammlungen”) Chemnitz*

With the famous Chemnitz opera, “König-Albert-Museum” and the church of Petri (“Petrikerche”), the theatre square (“Theaterplatz”) is one of the most beautiful architectural ensembles in the city.



*Karl-Marx-Monument*

The philosopher Karl-Marx was the namesake of the city Chemnitz between 1953 and 1990. His bust, 2 x 13 meters high, has shaped the cityscape ever since. The second largest portrait bust in the world, popularly known as “Nischl”, is now gilded as a local symbol of Chemnitz.



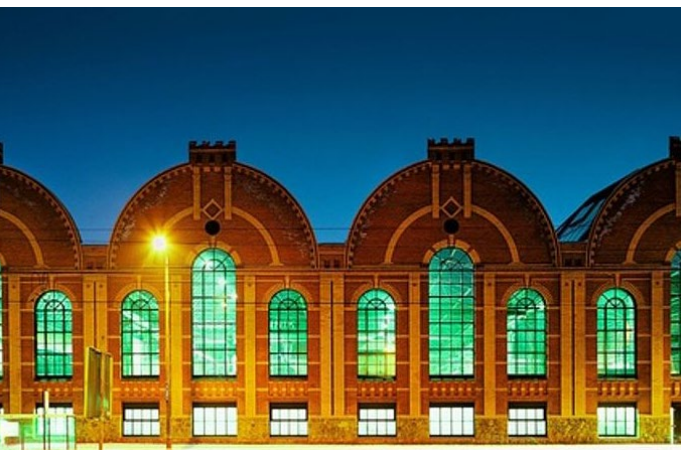
*The “Kaßberg”*

Only a few minutes away from the city center is one of the largest, coherently preserved founding period and art nouveau quarters in Europe. The district, popular with Chemnitz residents, is characterized by beautifully restored buildings and a large number of cafés, pubs and restaurants.



*Industrial culture and museums*

In Chemnitz you will find traces of industrial history everywhere. The industrial museum, the administration building of the former Hartmann works, the “Schönherr” factory, but also the “Villa Esche” and the railway viaduct over Annaberger street bear witness to the early days of Chemnitz.

# Museums, art & culture

*Visit and guided tour of the  
Chemnitz opera and the  
Chemnitz art collections  
("Kunstsammlungen")*

The Chemnitz opera is right across from our hotel. Whether ballet, musical, opera or symphony concert, the largest theatre in Chemnitz offers a varied program. In addition to the performances, the Chemnitz opera invites you to take a tour of the venerable walls. Find out interesting facts, get an insight into everyday theatre and listen to one or the other anecdote.

The "König-Albert-Museum", designed by Richard Möbius and opened in 1909, is also located on theatre square ("Theaterplatz") across from our hotel and houses the Chemnitz art collections ("Kunstsammlungen"). The exhibition includes over 60,000 exhibits, including many high-ranking works from the 19th and 20th centuries, for examples a collection of works by Karl Schmidt-Rottluff.

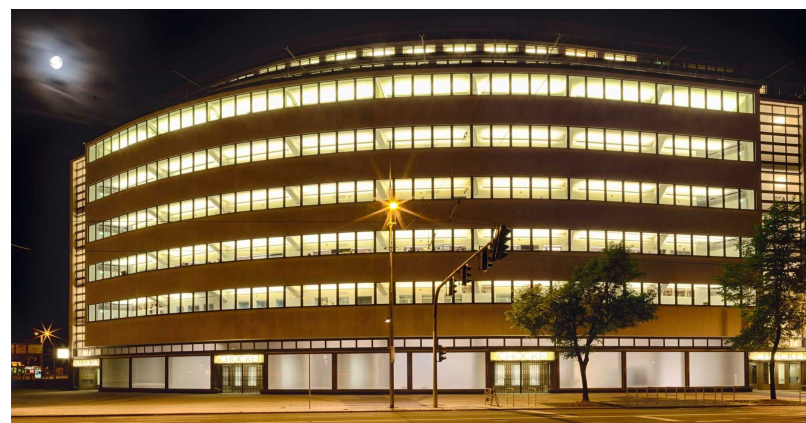


*Guided tours in "Gunzenhauser" museum*

Dr. Alfred Gunzenhauser, passionate art lover and gallery owner, donated 2,459 works by a total of 270 artists to the city of Chemnitz to remain. These include one of the world's largest Otto Dix collections and third largest collection of Alexej von Jawlensky's works.

*State Museum of archeology Chemnitz  
(Smac)*

The smac isn't only the shop window of the state office for archeology with its archive, but also Saxony's only museum in which you can learn everything about 300,000 years of human history. It isn't for nothing that smac has been appearing as the cultural ambassador of Saxony since 2004.







# Nature & recreation

## *Castle pond with castle church*

EA real gem is just a few minutes' walk from the center. The park around the lake fed by the "Pleißebach" invites you to stroll. Ideal for relaxing or letting yourself

drift on one of the rental gondolas in the sunshine. Should the weather not play along, the castle church – the place of origin of Chemnitz in the 12th century – on the adjacent castle hill invites you to visit.



## *Moated castle of Klaffenbach ("Wasserschloss Klaffenbach")*

The moated castle of Klaffenbach is located on the southern outskirts of Chemnitz. Surrounded by a landscaped park with a golf course and paths for strolling, the Renaissance castle enchants visitors with a total work of art consisting of the castle building, hotel, many restaurants and handicraft studios.

## *Leisure region Rabenstein*

The Rabenstein leisure region consists of Rabenstein castle, the smallest medieval castle in Saxony, the Oberrabenstein reservoir, the Rabenstein forest, the Chemnitz zoo and the rock dome ("Felsendome"). Here you will find relaxation and leisure fun near the city center for the whole family.

### *Maroon Bar*

### *Weltecho Chemnitz*

In the former “Chamber of Technology” on Annaberger street, Weltecho invites you to visit with colorful mix of independent cinema, exhibitions, concerts, parties and readings. In addition, there are regular theatre and dance performances.

And on the weekend, the Weltecho turns into one of the hippest clubs in town.





# Active in sports



The Chemnitz ice sports center is one of the renowned training facilities for internationally successful figure skating personalities. In addition to the roller hockey facility, the 400 m speed skating rink and the boarding school with additional training halls,

the complex also includes an ice rink with a capacity of 4000 spectators, which houses the Chemnitz Crashers ice hockey team from the regional league. If you like, you can also whiz across the ice on bare runners between October and March.



## *Boulderlounge Chemnitz*

The boulder lounge comprises a climbing area of around 850 qm on which 150 routes with six different levels of difficulty are screwed. There is also a training and course area as well as an area for children. A 150 qm lounge with changing bistro options invites you to handy out and relax.

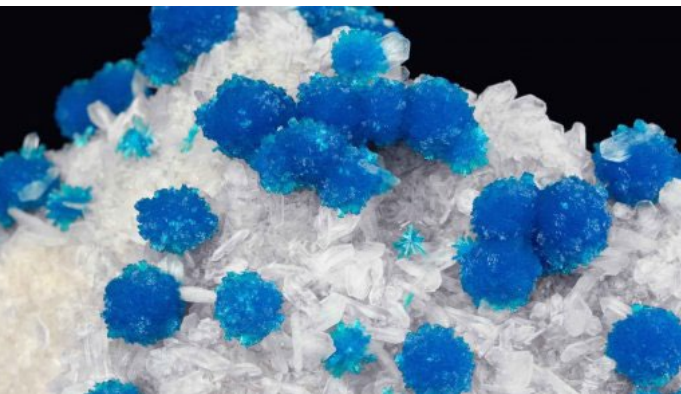


# Chemnitz area

## *Ore Mountains (Erzgebirge)*

The Ore Mountains (Erzgebirge) is the cradle of German Christmas traditions. For centuries, nutcrackers, candle arches or smoker figures have been made of wood here, which ensure cosiness during Advent. In different craft businesses you can look

over the shoulders of the masters at work and experience the traditional craft up close: for examples, turning tires in a Seiffen toy-making workshop, lace-making in an Annaberg parlor, making smoking candles with the popular Christmas scents and baking Ore Mountains (Erzgebirge) Christmas stollen.



## *terra mineralia Freiberg / TU Bergakademie Freiberg*

The terra mineralia in Freudenstein castle in Freiberg is the largest mineral exhibition in the world with over 80,000 exhibits. Given by Dr. Erika Pohl-Ströher as a permanent loan from the TU Bergakademie Freiberg, the exhibition shows a variety of crystals in different colors and shapes. The aesthetically pleasing minerals come from historical and current sites around the world.

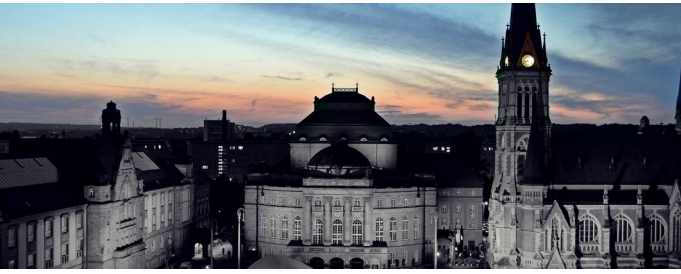
## *Augustusburg castle (Schloss Augustusburg)*

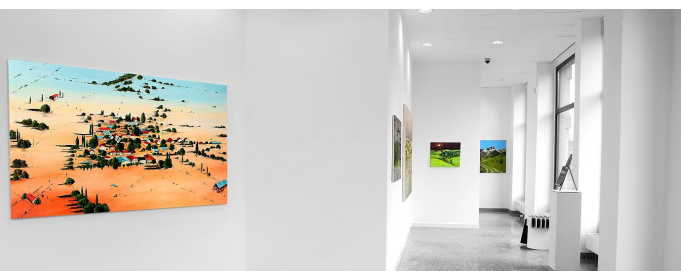

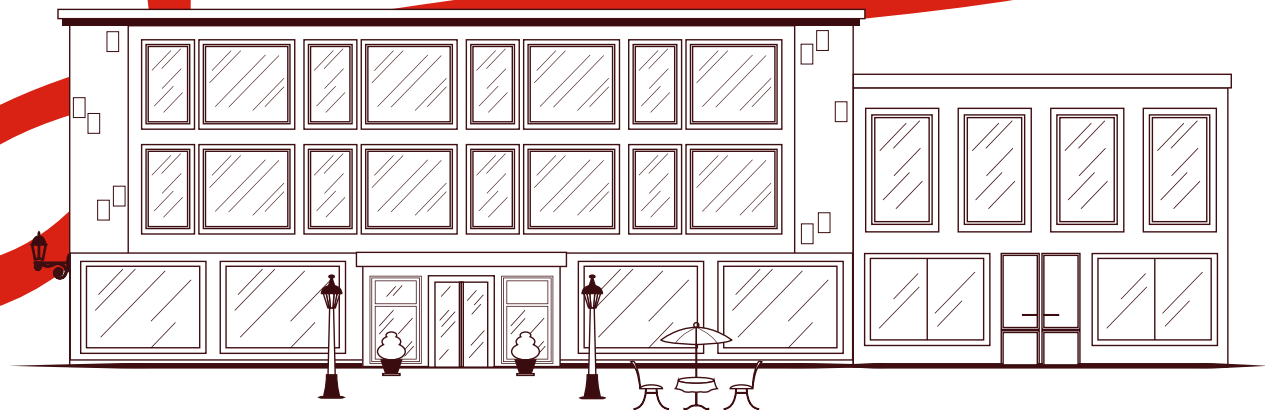
